Import of palm oil declines to eight-month low

in stocks, because of excessive imports during November-January, Solvent Extractors' Association (SEA) said on Wednesday. The reduction in palm oil imports by India, the world's biggest importer of vegetable oils, could weigh on Malaysian palm oil prices.

The country's palm oil imports fell to 586,007 tonne last month, the lowest since June 2022, SEA said in a statement. The country's palm oil imports during November to January jumped 86% from a

year ago because of lower prices even as demand was subdued due to winter months, said a Mumbai-based dealer with a global trade house. "Refiners are now giving preference to bringing down stocks. They have ample stocks

to cover short-term demand," he said. Soy oil imports in February eased nearly 3% from January to 355,840 tonne, while those of sunflower oil dropped 66% to 156,628 tonne from record high imports in January, the SEA said. —REUTERS

House panel concerned over low outlay for rural jobs

PARLIAMENT'S STANDING COMMITTEE on Rural Development has expressed concerns over a five-year low provision of ₹60,000 crore in the FY24 Budget for the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee scheme (MGNREGS). The panel, which submitted its report to the Rajya



Sabha on Wednesday, said the Budget estimates for MGNREGS have been reduced by

₹29,400 crore for 2023-24 when compared to the revised estimates of 2022-23.

The government, however, reiterated that being a demand-driven scheme, outlay for MGNREGS could be hiked in the course of the year, if the demand is high.

Recent months' data indeed show that the demand for the scheme is still elevated with supply doesn't matching up. "The Act governing (the scheme) provides 'Right to Work' to such deprived sections of the rural populace who are willing to work. "It is a last resort of succour for the jobless section who don't have any other means to feed them and their family members," the panel said in its report.

"The role and importance of MGNREGS were visible during the Corona pandemic when it acted as a ray of hope for the needy in times of distress," it said.

Official sources told FE recently that rampant misappropriation of funds allocated under the scheme is one of the reasons for the Centre to make a five-year low provision of ₹60,000 crore in the FY24 Budget for the jobs programme.

The MGNREGS, the government's largest social sector scheme, is administered by the rural development ministry.

For FY23, the government has enhanced the outlay for the rural job guarantee programme from ₹73,000 crore in the Budget Estimate (BE) to ₹89,400 crore in the revised estimate (RE).

Under the programme, the Centre has spent ₹98,468 crore in FY22 and a record ₹1.1 trillion during the Covid pandemic in FY21 to give succour to migrant labourers.

"After the big jump in FY21, it was observed that cartels at the state level and panchayat level look at the Budget and find a way of spending, whether there is demand or not," a senior official had told FE earlier.

The rural development ministry said: "There was an increase in the allocation in the previous two-three years because of the abnormal situations created due to Covid, the Ukraine war, and inflation... Now the situation has normalised a bit. In 2020-21, the original budget was ₹61,000 crore," the ministry said.

"Since it is a demand-driven scheme, when the need arose it was enhanced to ₹1,10,000 crore. Whenever there is a need for extra money, we go to the finance ministry and they allocate extra money for this. There is no dearth of money if the demand arises for wage employment," the ministry said.

Next round of India-Canada trade talks likely in April

THE NEXT ROUND of negotiations for the proposed interim trade agreement (FTA) between India and Canada is expected to be held in April, a senior commerce ministry official said on Wednesday.

Krishan Kumar, joint secretary in the department of commerce, said negotiations are at an advanced stage in goods & services and in other areas.

"Six rounds have completed. The seventh round may be held in April," he told reporters here.

In March last year, the two countries re-launched negotiations for an interim agreement, officially dubbed as an early progress trade agreement (EPTA).

Apart from traditional areas, the agreement may cover areas like SMEs, trade and gender, environment and labour.

"We have already exchanged goods offer and discussions are starting to improve the services offer," he said.
